


# Fifth Sunday in Lent Year B

John 12:20-33

## Àbòjnà Yesu Kristò ma Dzonè Nwà'anè â ñwa'arè, 12:20-33

All: Mèkwu'utènà dzwi a mbwo wwò, o Nfò wìi.

Bè bè Grikè bâtsà dzwi â tètè bè bu ma bwo ko'o nghè â ghwu'usè Nywe njwe nghwe la.

Bwo yii a mbwo Filibè ma à fu fè Betsiyidà fèfè Galili, nswiñè ambwo zhè ngè, " Ndè, bìi swa'a zĕ Yesù." Filibè ghè swiñè a mbwo Àndrèya bwo zhè ti'i nghè fi'itè a mbwo Yesù. Yesù a kwe a mbwo bwo ngè, "fè'è ku'u mè ngè bè fya aghu'usè a mbwo Moo Njù." Nè nko'onyù mè swiñè a mbwo bù ngè "Boñè mboñè ngwàsañè ka mèmè nshye wwò kwo, boñè à bè tiñè tsé'è mboñè mò'o zuzu; la boñè è kwo boñè è bă jwe mboñè ngha'atè. Bè bu ma bwo koñè mèdzwinè mya bè bye la bu ma bwo banè mèdzwinè mya nshye wi bè liñè nè mèdzwinè ma mè lyè kè mye. Njù ntsàmè wuma â fà'a mbwo mwo bè zoñè nè mwo. Â njù fà'è wa ntsàmè kè dzwi adi'i wuma mè dzwi wè. Njù ntsàmè wuma â fa'a mbwo mwo Ætàa wà bè lya ghwu'usè yé.



Ntiñè wa ghasè wa tsètsoñè, mè nti'i swiñè ngè kè, ngè – 'Ætàa wà, fusè wa mèmè fè'è wí? Ngañè, mè nyìi nku'u fè'è wu wi a mbè'è anyu zu zí. Ætàa, ghwu'usè əlwenè wwo. "Njì tsè ti'i nfû nèkàñè nswiñè ngè, "Mè ntè nghwu'usè, mè nkè bitè bù ghwu'usè." Nno bè wu ma a tiñè wu nzu'u nti'i nswiñè ngè à bă mbæñè ma à khwùrè. Batse nswiñè ngè andèrè bòñènè a mbwo zhè. Yesù swiñè ngè, "Nji zí yìi a mbè'è wu, kakè mbè'è wa bæ." Li be Fè'è tsèrè nsa'a nshye. Bă bè sàrè ñlinè nshye wi â ghè. Â mwo, fè'è wu ma bè lyè ntwe wa nshye ko'osè ndiñè, mè bâ lò bă bâtsàmè nèbenè mwò. Â boñènè lì a mè dèssènè mbuñè nèwwo zu ma zhè bæ kwo.

## John 12:20-33

12:20 Now among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks.

12:21 They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and said to him, “Sir, we wish to see Jesus.”

12:22 Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus.

12:23 Jesus answered them, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

12:24 Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

12:25 Those who love their life lose it, and those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life.

12:26 Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there will my servant be also. Whoever serves me, the Father will honor.

12:27 “Now my soul is troubled. And what should I say – ‘Father, save me from this hour’? No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour.

12:28 Father, glorify your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, “I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again.”

12:29 The crowd standing there heard it and said that it was thunder. Others said, “An angel has spoken to him.”

12:30 Jesus answered, “This voice has come for your sake, not for mine.

12:31 Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out.

12:32 And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.”

12:33 He said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die.
